In consideration of the undersigned paying the registration fee to United Way of Regina to attend and participate in the GenNext Sno-Pitch Tournament (the "Tournament") to be held on Saturday February 27, 2010 and for good and other valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, I, the undersigned:

(a) am aware that there are inherent risks associated with my attendance at, and participation in, the Tournament. I voluntarily assume all risk of injury (including, without limitation to, bodily injury, death or property damage) and risk of all other losses and damages howsoever arising either at law or in equity, that I may sustain, incur, suffer, or be put to, which arise out of or occur directly or indirectly by reason of my presence at, or participation in, the Tournament, whether or not caused by negligence;

(b) irrevocably and unconditionally waive any claim or legal action that I and/or my heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns may have relating to any injury or any other loss or damage that I may sustain, incur, or be put to, which arises out of, or occurs directly or indirectly by reason of my presence at, or participation in, the Tournament, whether or not caused by negligence;

(c) release, remise and forever discharge United Way of Regina and its organizers, supervisors, agents, employees directors, officers, servants, contractors, and representatives, and each of their respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns (collectively, the "Released Persons"), from and against any and all manner of claims, actions, causes of action, suits, costs, demands and expenses of whatsoever nature and kind that I may sustain, incur, suffer, or be put to, which arise or may arise out of or occur directly or indirectly by reason of my presence at, or participation in, the Tournament, whether or not caused by negligence;

(d) agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Released Persons from and against any and all manner of claims, actions, causes of action, suits, costs, demands and expenses of whatsoever nature and kind that I may sustain, incur, suffer, or be put to, which arise or may arise out of or occur directly or indirectly by reason of my presence at the Tournament, whether or not caused by negligence.

TOURNAMENT RULES SHEET

1. Each team will supply own gloves and bats. Each team shall umpire their own at-bats.
2. 1-blast from the air horn will indicate 5-minute warning; teams that are still playing on a diamond at that time must finish the current inning and call the game. If at the end of the current inning the score is tied please revert to a previous inning in which one team was leading as the final score.
3. 2-blasts from the air horn indicate the start of the game; please ensure you are ready to start your game at that time.
4. A team is in default if it has not fielded a team within 15 minutes of the scheduled starting time.
5. Teams shall consist of ten players, three of which must be of the opposite sex. Ten Players on the field at one time. To avoid defaults, a team must play with a minimum of eight players; two of which must be of the opposite sex.
6. A team may play with only two members of the opposite sex. The “third” member must still be placed in the batting order and an “out” taken every time that spot comes up in the batting order. This means you will only be able to bat nine batters. Anything less than two players of the opposite sex will result in a forfeit.
7. Substitutes must field before they bat. Teams may only go through their batting order once in an inning. The maximum is ten batters per inning. All players must bat; you can't start at the top of the order every inning.
8. Team Participant must be 19 years or older to participate in the Tournament.
9. All games will not exceed five innings or 1hr from the scheduled starting time, whichever comes first. In the event of a tie after five innings, the score is reverted to the previous inning in which a team had a lead.
10. The home team will be decided by a coin toss prior to game time in the presence of both team representatives.
11. The pitcher is on the opposing team, i.e normal baseball.
12. The pitch must arc to a height between 6' – 12'. Any pitches outside this can be called “No Pitch” by the umpire but must be called while the ball is still in the air. If the batter still chooses to swing the ball is considered to be live.
13. Home Plate is a 2' X 4' piece of plywood, runners must NOT touch home plate, and they must instead run behind home plate, runners touching home plate will be automatically called out.

14. Foul ball on the third pitched strike and the batter is out! Strikes are when the ball hits home plate. Foul Line will be identified as the base-lines.
15. One base per overthrow landing out of "Play". "Play Zone" is defined as within the bounds of the "Backstop".
16. No Bunting. Anyone who bunts is automatically out.
17. No stealing. Runners cannot leave a base until the ball is hit; runners who leave the base prior to ball being hit will be called out.
18. No metal or hard cleats allowed. There is no infield fly ball rule.
19. Winning team's representative(s) must ensure their completed score sheets are turned into the GenNext Committee Volunteers at the registration table located in the parking lot near the diamonds immediately following the game.

FYI

- Dress appropriately for the weather conditions.
- The tournament will proceed rain or shine.
- Registrations are non-refundable.
- Each team is guaranteed 3 games.
- Teams are required to supply their own equipment including bats and gloves. Game balls and bases are provided.
- A minimum of 3 members of the opposite sex are required per team.
- Cabaret will follow the tournament and prize presentations in the Callie Curling Club.
- Teams can register more than 10 players however only 10 cabaret tickets are included in the price. If extra members or guests wish to attend the cabaret you can purchase additional tickets in advance (from United Way before 5 p.m. Friday February 26, 2010) or day of (at the registration table in the Callie) for \$10/each.
- There will be two 50/50 draws during the tournament. The first draw will take place at 6 p.m. and the second at 10 p.m. You must be present to win.
- Food and beverage will be available at the Callie Curling Club throughout the day. A buffet dinner will be available for purchase following the tournament.
- Washrooms facilities are available at the Callie Curling Club throughout the day.
